

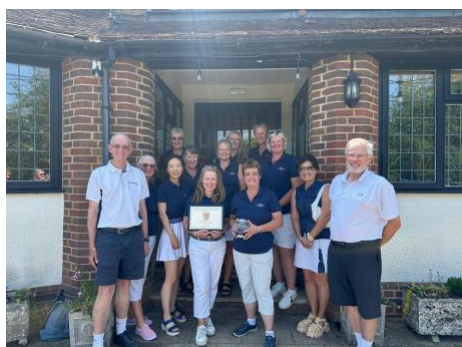
Pearson Surrey Finals Day Report 2025

Thursday 19th June 2025 at Bramley Golf Club

The culmination of a close and hard-fought Pearson season saw the four semi-finalists, Leatherhead, Burhill, St George's Hill and Royal Wimbledon at Bramley Golf Club early on the morning of the 19th June, an absolutely scorching day, ready for a potential 36-hole contest. As is usual after an early breakfast the semi-finals commenced at 8am with the Surrey Women's President, Ann Gems acting as our starter in the morning. Leatherhead played St George's Hill followed Burhill against Royal Wimbledon and so on until the ten matches had all teed off.
